

You start with a couple shots of the inside of the car, where the boost hose passes through into engine compartment:






Showing the parts off the TSI which had to be removed to route the hose properly. The TSI could be considered harder than the FSI since you also airbox:





Then a couple pics of the engine compartment side of that grommet, showing the hose coming into the engine compartment:





Next, to installing the 42dd boost tap. You first unplug the stock PCV hose by squeezing the two sides:





You then oil up your o-rings and press the 42dd boost tap into the intake fitting:






You insert is at this angle:



Then you turn it to slot the metal tabs into the intake manifold fins:



You then push your stock PCV hose back onto the new connector:






I left my vent side hose plugged ready for my boost gauge arrival in a couple days:



You can see the 3 yellow tie wraps where I ran the boost hose through the proper cleanest channel:



Finally, you attach the engine side of the hose to your boost tap fitting. They say you dont need a tie wrap but I use one just in case.



This work took me at least an hour, more like 1.5 hours taking my time. So when my gauge comes in all the hard work is done. I also have the she my headlight harness and have my side vent removed and disassembled.


