## Rear Wiper Blade Replacement

The rubber insert is just a standard refill.

Remove wiper arm by sliding centre cover to one side and removing from dowel.

Squeeze **blade** slides together at one end and pull cap off.

Repeat in centre (cap has a tang and slides off of centre clip) and other end .

Cut new **blade** to length and slip slides into side grooves.

Slide on end caps. (If loose or worn put a drop of glue on top of wiper rubber where cap sits)

Clip on centre cap and slide cover on to cap.







